BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Project Labor Agreement Coordinating Committee

3 For the purpose of revising thresholds for project labor agreements, making all County projects
4 valued at over \$10 million to have a mandatory project labor agreements approved by the Project
5 Labor Agreement Coordinating Committee for submission to the County Executive for their
6 approval and change the composition of the Coordinating Committee.

7 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

8 SUBTITLE 10A. PURCHASING.

9 Sections 10A-158 and 10A-158.00.01

10 The Prince George's County Code

11 (2019 Edition; 2022 Supplement).

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
13 Maryland, that Sections 10A-158 and 10A-158.00.01 of the Prince George's County Code be and
14 the same are hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

16 **DIVISION 6. SPECIAL PROVISIONS.**

17 **SUBDIVISION 13. PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENTS.**

18 **Sec. 10A-158. Project Labor Agreements.**

19 (a) All solicitations, including invitations for bids and requests for proposals, issued for
20 construction projects by the County that have an estimated dollar value of [One]Ten Million
21 Dollars (\$[1,000,000]10,000,000) or more [may]shall include a clause that requires the

1 execution and use of a Project Labor Agreement, as defined herein.

3 **Sec. 10A-158.00.01. Project Labor Agreement Coordinating Committee; composition;**
4 **duties.**

5 (a) There shall be a Project Labor Agreement Coordinating Committee comprised
6 of 10 representatives:

7 (1) The Chair[man]person of the [Public Safety and Fiscal Management]
8 Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee or the Chairperson's designee, [who shall
9 serve as the ex-officio member and who shall receive updates as to the status of pending and
10 current project labor agreement projects] shall serve as the Chairperson;

12 (3) The Director of Central Services or the Director's designee[, who shall serve
13 as Chairperson];

14 * * * * *

15 (c) The Committee shall meet at the call of the Chairperson of the Committee as
16 frequently as required to perform its duties to discuss progress of work, projections, and issues
17 on a current project. A majority of the members of the Committee shall constitute a quorum for
18 the transaction of business. A majority of those present at any meeting shall be sufficient for
19 any official action taken by the Committee. The Committee must approve by a vote of the
20 majority of members present, all project labor agreements to go before the County Executive
21 for approval before they become effective.

22 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
23 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
24 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
25 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining
26 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
27 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
28 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
29 or section.

1 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
2 calendar days after it becomes law.
